DAY 1: ARRIVAL AND WELCOME



Clients are greeted at YVR by CANN



Clients are taken by taxi or bus to temporary accommodations



Greeted by ISSofBC staff, assigned to their rooms, and provided \$20 for the first night

DAY 2: INTAKE AND INITIAL ASSISTANCE



Meet with first language counsellor: Intake, bank forms, consent Forms, receive orientation schedule



Meet with ISSofBC Housing Worker



Receive food cash

DAY 3-14: ORIENTATIONS, APPOINTMENTS AND HOUSING



Orientations: introduction to Welcome Centre, housing, and living in BC



Coping with Change Session: orientation (group) and needs assessment (individual/ family)



Immigration, Refugee & Citizenship Canada: IRCC intake



Banking: opening bank accounts



Primary Health (1 day): primary health (nurse and physician)



Permanent Housing Search: work with family unit to identify housing needs



Identify Options: arrange for client to visit potential housing with help of housing search volunteer



Sign Lease/Housing Agreement: once lease/ housing agreement is finalized arrange for furniture delivery/move-in

RAP: FROM ARRIVAL TO PERMANENT HOUSING



Clients are Greeted at YVR by CANN and sent by bus/taxi to temporary accommodation sites in Vancouver, Richmond or Surrey
